Critical to the success of the school program is the parental support and cooperation with the policies and procedures established by the parish and the school administrators. There are specific financial requirements to maintain a quality program. Over 80% of the school's budget is covered by tuition and fees. The criteria for parish support and payment of tuition and fees are outlined below.

The school has published a handbook which can be found on the web site outlining the procedures and policies for an effective program. It is expected that all students and parents comply and cooperate with all school policies as stated in the handbook.

Three Tier tuition rates have been established for the 2012-2013 school year:

- Catholic Parish Tuition Rate---families registered and in good standing within St. John/ Holy Angels Parish
- Catholic Out-of-Parish Tuition Rate-families registered in another Catholic parish.
- Non-Catholic Tuition Rate ---Non-Catholic families or families not registered or in good standing within a parish.

Tuition and Fees

_____ **Catholic (Member of St. John-Holy Angels Parish)**

As a member of St. John-Angels Holy Parish, we understand that we are responsible for tuition and fees (Payable July 2012~ May 2013) as noted on the tuition and fee schedule. We also understand that we are expected be in "good standing" within the parish in order to qualify for the Parish Tuition Rate which includes participation in worship, sacraments, fellowship and stewardship to the church. This stewardship is defined as a contribution of \$15 a week (\$780 annually) to the church. This parish subsidy helps supplement tuition and the total cost of educational services.

_____ **Catholic (Member of _____ Parish)**

As a member of the aforementioned parish, we understand that we are responsible for tuition and fees (Payable July 2012~ May 2013) as noted on the tuition and fee schedule. We also understand that we are expected be in "good standing" within that parish in order to qualify for the Out-of- Parish Tuition Rate which includes participation in worship, sacraments, fellowship and stewardship to the church. As a member of this parish, we must have the pastor of this parish complete and return the parish form with your registration packet.

_____ **Non-Catholic**

We are Non-Catholic or we are not registered and/or not in "good standing" at any Catholic Parish. We understand that we are responsible for tuition and fees (Payable July 2011~ May 2012) as noted on the tuition and fee schedule for Non-Catholics.
