

## **Snacks**

Each day, students will receive a snack such as pretzels, popcorn, chips, cookies, and granola bars. Students may bring their own snacks to replace or supplement the snack provided. The following items are prohibited: chewing gum, lollipops, glass bottles, cans, small hard candies or other items that present a choking hazard.

## **Conduct**

The general standards of conduct for Holy Angels School apply to AfterCare, including the bullying policy. In cases of repeated misconduct, the student will not be permitted to continue in AfterCare.

The following considerations warrant special mention for AfterCare. Students may bring their own games to AfterCare, but are not to be used during homework time. The following items are prohibited at all times: cellular phones, Game Boys, CD/MP3 players, headsets, remote control vehicles, devices that are noisy, and objects that are sharp or otherwise dangerous. Any prohibited object will be taken from the student and returned upon request when he/she leaves for the day.

Students should always bring a book to read during homework hour. Reading quietly after homework is completed allows others to finish their work. AfterCare has a small selection of books if needed.

Students may not throw or toss balls, paper airplanes, or other objects indoors except in organized games overseen by a counselor.

No more than three (3) students in the restroom at any time; no dawdling in the restroom.

Prior to being picked up by his/her parent, a student may leave the AfterCare premises only with authorization from a teacher, a school official or other authorized person.

Students shall take good care of the games and equipment provided by AfterCare. Improper usage of games is prohibited and students must clean up when the game is over.

Every student shall work to keep the AfterCare premises tidy and free of snack debris and other trash. This duty applies even though the student may not have been using the game in question or may not have been the source of the trash. A student may not refuse to help with clean-up on the grounds the mess was created by someone else.

When AfterCare activities take place in the classrooms, students must take special care to keep hands off property found in these classrooms.

Students shall follow the instructions of the counselors and the director; no arguing, backtalk, sarcasm, or other disrespectful responses.

## **Donations**

Please consider donating to the AfterCare program any unwanted items, such as games; coloring books; CD's and movies; white or colored paper; yarn and ribbon; paper towel tubes; tissue paper; picture calendars; egg cartons; or any other items that can be used in a creative crafts project.

## **Picking up your child(ren)**

Only authorized persons will be able to pick up your child(ren). Authorized persons are those listed on the registration form. A picture ID will be required for anyone other than a parent and a written note must be submitted in advance if someone other than a parent will be signing out your child.

## **Parking lot safety**

After entering school grounds to pick up your children, slow your car to 5 miles per hour. Always assume there will be children playing outside near the driveways and parking lots.
